Bribie Island Rd Saddle Club Inc. Terms and Conditions of Membership As Of 1st October 2024

1. Membership

- (a) By signing to become a member of the Bribie Island Rd Saddle Club Inc. (henceforth referred to as BIRSCI), the applicant becomes a member of the association and thus agree to these terms and conditions in full.
- (b) As a member of BIRSCI you are required to adhere to the rules and by-laws of the association. Copies of these can be found on the BIRSCI website or provided in hard copy upon request (a printing fee may apply).
- (c) Your membership with BIRSCI is a lifetime membership until such time that it is terminated under the Association's rules
- (d) BIRSCI reserves the right to reject an application for membership for any reason which is decided by the management committee under the association's rules.
- (e) Members agree that they will not enter or remain within the BIRSCI facility if they are under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.
- (e) There is to be no alcohol or drugs within the BIRSCI facility unless within the guidelines of BIRSCI Drug and Alcohol policy (f) BIRSCI is a youth sporting organisation.
- (g) Smoking is only allowed in the designated smoking area.

2. Member's Commitment

- (a) Every member must commit themselves to follow the club's Code of Conduct and other BIRSCI policies all of which can be found on our website at www.BSaddleClub.com/Policies.
- (b) A student must take any reasonable and lawful direction as given to them by their riding instructor.
- (c) As safety is paramount at BIRSCI, it is very important that relevant safety equipment, such an approved helmet and appropriate clothing when riding, must be worn at all times as instructed by the instructor.
- (d) The student must commit to being on time to each lesson booked. As there will often be a lesson booked after your lesson, an extension of your lesson will not be possible if you arrive later than you have booked for. If for any reason the lesson is cut short by circumstances beyond the student's control (eg thunderstorm), BIRSCI will make up the time lost at a subsequent lesson or at a suitable time to both BIRSCI and the student.

3. Horse Riding Lessons and Activities

- (a) All members/ students are to be in sound physical condition and undertake participation with the knowledge of the physical demands required.
- (a) Horse riding is a high-risk activity and horses can be hazardous. Horses are unpredictable by nature, that when frightened their instincts are to jump forward or sideways, to run away from danger, to kick, to rear up or to bite.
- (b) BIRSCI takes every possible precaution to ensure the safety of its students and members while they are under instruction. Safety precautions are a service and not a guarantee. BIRSCI accepts no liability or responsibility for any loss or injury which a member/ student may sustain while participating in any BIRSCI activity, either directly or indirectly.
- (c) By completing the membership application and acknowledging that these terms and conditions have been read by the member or their representative, the member confirms their understanding of the inherent risks involved with horses and absolves BIRSCI, or its servants, agents representatives or volunteers from any responsibility or liability in the case of an accident.
- (d) In the case of any accident, a BIRSCI staff member may initiate first aid and, if need be, call for an ambulance. First Aid administered on behalf of BIRSCI is a service to members, but not a guarantee
- (e) At any time horses belonging/ leased to BIRSCI are being handled or ridden, members are to be directly

- supervised by one of BIRSCI's qualified instructors. The only exception is if a member has been deemed as competent to do the task required by an assessor from our education partner Ausintec Academy.
- (f) While the instructors may also inspect the riding equipment from time to time, it is ultimately the members/ students' responsibility to check equipment, including the saddle, and if there are any problems, or the saddle becomes loose, they should tell their instructor immediately.
- (g) All students to follow instructor's directions at all times.
- (h) It is a condition of riding to wear a helmet, suitable footwear and other protective clothing and to follow arena rules.
- (i) BIRSCI is located on a rural property and there are infinite trips hazards which are not individually identified. These include uneven surfaces, changes in surface texture, holes, rocks, sticks and branches. All members should look up, be careful and not take unnecessary risks.

4. Booking of Lessons

- (a) It is preferable that lessons are booked online (www.BSaddleClub.com/Lessons) and pre-paid at the time of making the booking
- (b) As our instructors are contracted in advance to deliver the lessons, any cancellation of the booking must be made with more than 24 hours' notice to receive a full refund (less the booking fee of \$10.00)

5. Media

- (a) BIRSCI may from time to time record audio and visual images of members and their horses while doing activities at the BIRSCI facility.
- (b) BIRSCI also reserves the right to alter such recordings by any means necessary to that they are suitable for promotional and education purposed as desired by BIRSCI and/ or their education partner Ausintec Academy.
- (c) By becoming a member of the association, the member authorises the use of such recording for any educational, promotional or any other purpose which the management of BIRSCI sees fit, including releasing images for use by BIRSCI's education partner Ausintec Academy.
- (d) Members do not have any right to the BIRSCI material above.
- (d) No BIRSCI member is authorised to speak to any media representative regarding BIRSCI without the express permission of the BIRSCI management committee.
- (e) No BIRSCI member is authorised to record any audio or visual material within the BIRSCI facility without the express permission of the BIRSCI management committee.
- (f) All outside Media access and permissions will be managed by the BIRSCI Management Committee.

6. Guardianship of Minors

- (a) A member/ student who is under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian while on the BIRSCI facility.
- (b) Parents and guardians must sign on behalf of minors all documents pertaining to the activities which their minors undertake.

7. Use of BIRSCI Equipment

- (a) All equipment required for lessons are included in the lesson fees.
- (b) Equipment must be handled with care and respect and used only as instructed by the instructor.
- (c) All members/ students are held responsible for any injury cause to a horse, damage to premises, property owned by others, injuries to other riders or pedestrians or any equipment due to their neglect, mistreatment or reckless or irresponsible conduct.
